

From the Elders' Desk

Time Come! For the Purpose-Driven Pastor

Edited message by Bro Anthony Robinson at the Installation Service for Pastor Calvin Isaacs, February 9, 2025.

OUR GOD is purpose driven. As to a purpose-driven pastor we would look at Jeremiah 3:15 as the Biblical basis of my charge to Dr. Isaacs.

The Lord through his prophet promised he would restore backsliding Judah and return them to Zion to realise his purpose and he would provide them with pastors to do so. These pastors would enter with divine appointments, would enjoy divine alignment and would execute divine assignment. So, Pastor Isaacs, I would want you to know that:

You enter with Divine Appointment. “I will give them pastors. “It is God who have appointed you, though there was a process of pointing out by the saints. While some will say sheep cannot appoint shepherd, the people of God are more than sheep, they are saints, and the saints shall judge angels and the world according to 1 Corinthians 6. Saints are qualified to point out those God has appointed. Here at Elim all deacons, elders and now a pastor were pointed out by the saints, as was done in the Acts of the Apostles.

The pointing out comes after some time of serving. God said through Ezekiel in Chapter 34:23 that he would appoint over his people one shepherd, David His servant. Pastor Isaacs you are the Lord’s servant appointed as shepherd. Shepherd servant or servant shepherd, understanding that you are the Lord’s servant is key to your success. The Hebrew (Ebed) means a slave. The good shepherd, the great shepherd, and chief shepherd took on the role of slave in John 13, when he stooped down to wash his disciples’ feet, even the one he knew would betray him. Pastor Isaacs, we encourage you to follow His example of humility.

You engage with Divine Alignment. “Pastors according to mine heart...” The heart speaks to the intellect, the will and the emotions. The apostle Paul made the mind-blowing statement in 1 Corinthians 2: 16. That we who are indwelt by The Spirit of God have the mind of Christ. Then you should be aligned with the emotions of the Chief Shepherd. In Matthew 9:36 “But when He saw the multitudes, He was moved with compassion for them, because they were weary and scattered, like sheep having no shepherd.” Moved with compassion speaks to visceral empathy that is a close understanding of another person's experience, where you feel their emotions as if they were your own. The heart involves the will. Being aligned with will of the Chief Shepherd comes from abiding in His Word. John 15: 7 “If you remain in me and my words remain in you, ask whatever you wish, and it will be done for you.”

You execute your Divine Assignment. “Who will feed you with knowledge and understanding.” Feed is to tend, to lead to graze. With knowledge and understanding can speak to the kind of food the shepherd provides, but also the way the shepherd dispenses the food.



It's Time to Rise and Build

Response from Pastor Calvin Isaacs at his Installation Service as Pastor. I will be focusing on certain areas such as:

- Evangelism and discipleship
- Small group ministry
- Relationship building with individuals and community groups
- Pastoral care
- Children and youth ministries
- Teaching and preaching ministry

It is important to note that the appointment of a pastor does not change the leadership structure of the church. The elders are still in charge, and the pastor’s role is to lead in the execution of the elders’ vision and programmes. The appointment of the pastor means also that more may be asked of members in terms of their willingness to sacrificially do their part in ensuring that Elim Assembly is effectively carrying out the mandate received from the Lord.

There is much work to be done. It is also clear that if we are to move the assembly in the direction the Lord wishes to take us, there are at least three things we must pay attention to:

- Time
- Service and
- Intentionality

We must value and use our time wisely to accomplish the tasks we undertake. Time is a valuable but limited resource and so its utility must be maximised. We are all here for one purpose, and that is to serve. Jesus said, “I came not to be served, but to serve”. It follows then that our job is to serve, and if we serve together, we accomplish much more than disjointedly. We must be intentional in all we do, otherwise we will

not rise above mediocrity. God requires excellence, and we can only achieve excellence in service when we do so intentionality.

It is time to rise and build, and I invite everyone to do so.
