FROM THE **ELDERS'** DESK

The Indwelling Of The Holy Spirit

Presentation by Pastor Calvin Isaacs at Adult Bible Class

AT THE MOMENT of salvation, the Holy Spirit begins to dwell (live) in the body of the believer.

Do you not know that your bodies are temples of the Holy Spirit, who is in you, whom you have received from God? You are not your own; ²⁰ you were bought at a price. Therefore, honour God with your bodies (1 Cor. 6:19-20).

This indwelling of the Holy Spirit is fulfilment of what he said to his disciples in John 16:7.

But very truly I tell you, it is for your good that I am going away. Unless I go away, the Advocate will not come to you; but if I go, I will send him to you.

The Holy Spirit comes to live in the believer permanently. Every believer is indwelt by the Holy Spirit.

You, however, are not in the realm of the flesh but are in the realm of the Spirit, if indeed the Spirit of God lives in you. And if anyone does not have the Spirit of Christ, they do not belong to Christ (Rom. 8:9).

The body of the believer is the temple of the Holy Spirit. A temple is a holy place where God dwells and is a place of significance and reverence. As long as a person is born again the Holy Spirit resides in him. Therefore, the Holy Spirit, who is a gift from God will not be taken away from us

God's Irrevocable Gifts

The gifts and calling of God are irrevocable (He does not change or annul what He does (Rom. 11:29; Mal. 3:6) His presence with us is a consequence of our identification with God. We are His people, and He is our God

And I heard a loud voice from the throne saying, "Look! God's dwelling place is now among the people, and he will dwell with them. They will be his people, and God himself will be with them and be their God (Rev. 21:3).

He said to me, "Son of man, this is the place of My throne and the place of the soles of My feet, where I will dwell among the sons of Israel forever (Ezek. 47:3a)

--God dwelling with His people begins, not at the Rapture, or when the believer enters heaven, but at the point of Salvation

--The indwelling of the Holy Spirit is synonymous with God dwelling with us. God's dwelling with us is not time-bound, but for all eternity

--The indwelling of the Holy Spirit is not conditional on our conduct but guaranteed because God has immersed us into his divine community where he dwells.

However, the power to live the Christian life flows not from the indwelling of the Spirit, but from our partnership with him through obedience to the word of God. Thus, the powerful Spirit-filled life is not guaranteed but conditional on the extent to which we live in accordance with his word.
