# FROM THE **ELDERS'** DESK

## Positive Responses to The Holy Spirit

Presentation by Pastor Calvin Isaacs at Adult Bible Class

*In July newsletter we read about Cleansing (John 15:3) as a positive response of obedience by the Spirit-led believer. We continue to look at other responses.*

### **Yielding (Rom. 12: 1-2)**

- Yielding is the commitment of our entire being to God – body, soul, mind and spirit.
- The things we yield to are the things that we will serve, thus he exhorts us to yield to God (Rom. 6:13; 19).
- Again, it is obedience to the word that gives the Spirit the space and permission to work in us to cause us to want to yield ourselves completely to God for his purposes.
- It is the Holy Spirit who makes us aware of the things in our lives that hinder our spiritual growth; but it is we ourselves who must exercise the will to.

### **Abiding (John 15: 4-7)**

- To abide is “to stay put” or to “remain in one place”.
- We are not to be easily swayed by what seems attractive or extraordinary.
- We cannot be fruitful if we cannot remain faithful to the word of God.
- In Eph. 4:14 Paul exhorts us not to be “tossed to and fro, and carried about by every wind of doctrine (teaching), or by the sleight of men (trickery), or cunning craftiness” (unscrupulous conduct); instead, we are urged to “grow up into him in all things...”
- We must abide (or be anchored) in the word of God.

### **Walking (Gal. 5:16)**

- As believers we are commanded to walk in the Spirit.
- The act of walking connotes progress – moving from one place to the next. As believers in Christ we must progress, i.e., mature in our Christian living to please the Lord. He has no pleasure in people who are stuck or regressing. He wants to grow up, learn new things, and apply the new knowledge to our daily lives
- There must be progress in our Christian living if we are to please the Lord (2 Cor. 3:18)
- If we are not walking in the Spirit, we are fulfilling the desires of the flesh (our human wills)
- The word of God exhorts us to walk in newness of life (Rom. 6:4), honesty (Rom.13:13), faith (2 Cor. 5:7), good works (Eph. 2:10), worthiness (Eph 4:1), love (Eph. 5:2); to walk circumspectly (Eph 5:15) and as children of light (Eph. 5:8).

**Ministry Name:** Couples' Ministry

**Ministry Goal:** The Ministry seeks to celebrate Eros love between married men and women and encourage biblical principles in marriage. It serves to highlight the fact that our relationships are a living metaphor for Christ's relationship with the church as outlined in Ephesians 5 vs. 22-33.

**Role within the church:** Elim Couples' Ministry provides a space for biblical study by teaching the word of God as relates to marriage. It is a prayer-based ministry which is endorsed by our Elders and stands ready to assist believers by providing answers to their questions regarding marriage and relationships.

**Ministry Activities:** The group meets monthly to discuss and be informed on topics that affect all areas of marriage. Meetings include the sharing of thoughts and advice during question and answer sessions. There are also prayer sessions and presentations from strong bible teachers. On an annual basis, events are held to promote fun and fellowship among the ministry's members and these include the Valentine's Day dinner and couples' weekend trip.

### **What are the indicators of the Ministry's success?**

Positive feedback from members and visitors alike. Also, the continued endorsement of the ministry by the church leaders and the enduring spirit of the group which keeps the ministry thriving and growing from year to year.

**Meeting Schedule:** Meetings are held online every 3rd Sunday from 6pm to 8pm, although plans are in place to resume meetings in the church hall later this year.

**How can believers help or join the ministry:** Membership is open to any married couple. Once persons have consented to join, they are added to the ministry's WhatsApp group and membership becomes official. Believers who are not members of the Couples' Ministry are encouraged to continue praying for the ministry and for marriages as a whole.
