

# FROM THE ELDERS' DESK

## The Filling of The Holy Spirit

Presentation by Pastor Calvin Isaacs at Adult Bible Class

The Filling of the Spirit – Under the influence of the Holy Spirit of God. *Do not get drunk on wine, which leads to debauchery. Instead, be filled with the Spirit (Eph. 5:18)*

The filling of the Holy Spirit enables the believer to do the work that God has appointed him to do. *For we are God's handiwork, created in Christ Jesus to do good works, which God prepared in advance for us to do (Eph. 2:10)*

God created each believer to do good works that will magnify the goodness and grace of God. God works in the believer to accomplish that which will magnify him and glorify his name. *For it is God who works in you to will and to act in order to fulfil his good purpose (Phil. 2:13).*

God approves of his work being done through his resources (e.g., spiritual gifts) under the guidance of the Holy Spirit (the filling) To be filled with the Holy Spirit is to be submitted fully to him for him to work through us. The Holy Spirit, in his filling, enables those who serve to do God's work with God's resource in God's way *If anyone speaks, they should do so as one who speaks the very words of God. If anyone serves, they should do so with the strength God provides, so that in all things God may be praised through Jesus Christ. To him be the glory and the power for ever and ever. Amen (1 Pet. 4:11).*

The filling of the Spirit enables the believer to acknowledge the Lordship of Christ, and to see himself for who he really is - a mere servant of Christ ***There is no single manifestation that is the sole indicator that one is filled with the Spirit***

The filling of the Holy Spirit enables the believer to:

- speak the truth in love
- teach the word as he has been taught by the Holy Spirit
- live a life of holiness that brings glory to the Lord Jesus
- be gracious and Christ-like
- be loving and obedient
- be fruitful in every good work
- be self-controlled

How Can the child of God be Filled with the Spirit of God?

*By obeying the word of God.*

*The filling of the Spirit is NOT a one-time occurrence in the life of the believer; it is an oft-repeated action by the Spirit in the life of the believer when the believer is submitted to the Spirit of God (Eph. 5:18)*

*The filling of the Spirit happens every time the believer is completely surrendered to the Spirit.*

**Ministry Name:** Elim Assembly Performing Arts Ministry

**Ministry Leader:** Michelle Ferguson

**Vision Statement:** "Let everything that has breath praise the Lord." *Psalms 150:6. Our vision is to cultivate a generation of passionate worshippers who use their God-given talents in singing, dancing, sign language, drama, and dub poetry to glorify God, edify the church, and inspire the community. Through creative expressions of faith, we aim to empower youth to develop spiritually, grow in confidence, and impact the world for Christ.*

### MINISTRY ACTIVITIES

**Singing Ministry:** Focus on vocal training, harmonization, and worship leading.

**Dance Ministry:** Teaching and incorporating various dance forms and technique, including liturgical, contemporary, and cultural forms to highlight spiritual themes, tell biblical stories, bring scripture to life, etc.

**Sign Language Ministry:** Train participants in the art of using sign language in worship.

**Drama/Dub Poetry Ministry:** Teach the art of spoken word and dub poetry with a focus on biblical themes. Also, encourage youth to address social and spiritual issues through their poetry.

**Key Responsibilities:** The main roles within the ministry are for trainers with experience in any of the performing arts areas or for persons who are willing to act as chaperones to assist in managing/monitoring the children.

### What are the indicators of the Ministry's success

- Transformed Lives: Members and audiences growing spiritually, feeling convicted, uplifted, or inspired by performances.
- Increased Worship Engagement: Congregation participation in worship is more heartfelt and expressive due to the ministry's influence.

- Growth in Talent and Skill: Members are developing and becoming more confident in their artistic gifts.

**Meeting Schedule:** Ministry members will meet on a weekly basis primarily to conduct training exercises with the children.
