The Leading of The Holy Spirit

Presentation by Pastor Calvin Isaacs at Adult Bible Class

For as many as are led by the Spirit of God they are the sons of God (Rom. 8:14)

- God does not drive or compel His people to obey His word
- He wants us to obey him because we choose to do so out of love
- He goes before us to lead (Ps. 23: 2b, 3b) and guide us (Ps. 32:8)
- Since he guides us with his eye, we must keep our eyes on him
- It is consistent with the modus operandi of the Holy Spirit that we be sensitive to his leading
- That is, we should be in tune with him and expect to hear from him – where he wants us to go, what he wants us to do etc
- Heb. 12: 2b,3 says that Jesus is ahead of us and we must voluntarily follow His leading
- Jesus told His disciples that the Holy Spirit would come to guide us into all truth.

But when he, the Spirit of Truth comes, he will guide you into all the truth. He will not speak on his own; he will speak only what he hears, and he will tell you what is yet to come (John 16:13).

- The Holy Spirit leads the child of God only when that child of God obeys the word of God (Gen. 24:27b)
- The Holy Spirit reveals God's will regarding the believer's service or ministry (Acts 8:29; 13:2)
- There are many ways in which he chooses to direct those seeking a field of service, examples are:
 - Advice of Godly friends
 - Feeling burdened about a need or area
 - Inner prompting
 - Being constrained after praying about an issue
- Regular reading of the word of God is a must for all believers
- To neglect to read the word is to limit the influence of the Holy Spirit over our lives
- To neglect the reading of the word is to prevent the Holy Spirit from leading the believer.

Main Goals: The Ministry aims to:

Ministry's role within the Church: The Youth Ministry seeks to help with the growth of the Assembly by edifying our youths and encouraging them to become a part of the Kingdom of God.

Key Responsibilities: Providing the necessary support for weekly youth meetings including refreshments and human resources to ensure proper order is maintained. Also, meeting special needs of the youths such as transportation to facilitate their attendance at events hosted by other churches.
